IF PETER PREACHED HERE

What do you suppose the apostle Peter might say to this congregation if he had an opportunity to preach to us this Sunday? I don't know the answer to that question, but considering that the assembly is overwhelmingly made up of Christian, he might say, "**Have unity of spirit, sympathy, love of the brethren, a tender heart and a humble mind**" (I Peter 3:8).

Unity is always necessary. Dissensions destroy. This is true whether you are talking about a marriage, a business, or a church. Paul urged "that there be no dissensions among you," and Peter urges the same. We must do everything we can to promote peace and harmony.

Sympathy calls upon us "to suffer with another" or to "be touched with," or "have compassion." It is what Christ has for us, and what we should have one for another.

Love of the brethren is a theme which cannot be overstressed. Such love must not be limited to our own little circle of friends. It must reach out to all in the local church, and the brotherhood as a whole.

A **tender heart** is desired by Peter. How different things would be if we were "affectionately sensitive," quick to feel and to show affection. If we are not careful, our hearts may become hardened.

A **humble mind** keeps us from feeling or acting as if we are better than other folks. This is the right spirit in which to live before God and man.

Even if we don't have Peter in our pulpit this Sunday, we still need to hear and heed his words.
