Phillip Satterfield is the youngest son of Drake & Annette Satterfield. He was baptized into the body of Christ in 1974, and worshipped with the Olive Street Church of Christ (now Piedmont Road) in Marietta, GA as a young man.

After graduating from Greater Atlanta High School, bro. Satterfield began his career preaching the Gospel at the Cedar Grove congregation located in Camden, TN. He served there from 1983 - 1985. In 1986, he served as the Youth Minister at the Scotts Hill congregation in Scotts Hill, TN until 1987. Phillip received his B.A. degree in Bible from Freed-Hardeman University that same year.

After completing his degree, bro. Satterfield continued his work in spreading the gospel as Assistant Minister at the Husson Avenue Church of Christ in Palatka, FL (1987-1990). He returned to Georgia in 1990, and served as the pulpit Minister for the Canton congregation from 1991-1999. Since August 1999, he has preached the Word at the Macland Road Church of Christ in Marietta, GA.

Additionally, Bro. Satterfield's work is supported by his wife, Ellen (Barnette), whom he married during their time at Freed-Hardeman in 1985. They have one daughter, Sara, who was born in 1992.
