WHICH SERVICES OF THE CHURCH WILL WE ATTEND?

Was the writer of the Book of Psalms a Christian? No. But he had a wonderful attitude about coming to the place where the Jews assembled to worship God. He said, "*I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD*" (Psalm 122:1). What about you and me? I want to exhort my brothers and sisters who attend the services. "*But exhort one another daily . . . and let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works*" (Hebrews 3:13; 10:24).

I know what our Heavenly Father says about the assemblies of the church. "*Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is*" (Hebrews 10:25).

I don't want God and others to think that I am lukewarm in my service to Jesus. "*I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I could wish you were cold or hot. So then, because you are lukewarm. . . I will vomit you out of my mouth*" (Revelation 3:14,15)

I know that it will help me grow closer to God and other Christians. "*Draw nigh to God, and He will draw nigh to you*" (James 4:8).

I know that the strongest congregations are those where the members regularly attend services. "*Be ye steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labor is not in vain in the Lord*" (1 Corinthians 15:58).
