Blessed Is The Nation

The Psalmist wrote, "Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD; and the people whom he hath chosen for his own inheritance" (Psa. 33:12). These words have a direct reference to Israel of old. God chose Israel as His possession, "For thou art a holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth" (Dt.7:6). This concept has for many years been applied to The United States of America. Our country, from its beginning, has been characterized as a Christian nation. Many phrases have supported the idea. *In God We Trust, God Bless America* and many other statements confirm the concept that America is God's nation. The pledge of allegiance, "One nation under God..." and a song that has risen to popularity since September 11, 2001, "God Bless America". Israel, God's chosen people, did not remain His people for long. The people went after strange gods, in direct rebellion to God's commands. "They provoked him to jealousy with strange gods, with abominations provoked they him to anger. They sacrificed unto devils, not to God; to gods whom they knew not, to new gods that came newly up, whom your fathers feared not. Of the Rock that begat thee thou art unmindful, and hast forgotten God that formed thee" (Dt. 32:16-18). Many look upon Israel and declare them to be a "godless nation", however, they were not godless for they served many gods. A nation may be viewed as "godless" when they disregard the standard God has established. Certainly, Israel's history is one of disregard to God and His way.

What about America? Are we a "Christian" or God fearing society? If we look at the many ways in which our nation has departed from God's way, we cannot in honesty think of ourselves as a people of God. In recent times we have seen widespread departures from God's will. Homosexuals can marry, promotion of gambling, prostitution, and a major political party champions the killing of babies. The United States of America is not a godless nation, "In God We Trust" is our motto, but which one?

America trusts in many gods; The god of success, the god of money, the god of pleasure, the god of sex, the god of fame, the god of power, and on and on we could go. With the worship of so many gods is it surprising the one true God has been forgotten?

The nation who worships and serves God will be blessed. Our nation has been the recipient of many blessings, but for how much longer will we enjoy them? In order for us to be a "Nation under God" we must live under the laws of the God of Heaven. We must respect God and honor His laws. The nation must respect His name.

Some one said, "If the Native Americans had a more strict immigration policy, we would not be in the mess we are in." Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, begins with one person at a time.
