Dear Friends,

As the command was given by our Lord, Jesus Christ to his disciples to "go into all the world to teach His gospel to all people" we still must heed to that command today. You may know that Brittany and I have been on mission trips before, going to Honduras in 2004 and 2005 working with Latin American Mission out of Valdosta, Ga. We are planning again to go to Honduras in July 2008, to a little village called San Francisco for a medical and evangelistic campaign. The sponsoring congregation of the campaign is the South Knoxville church of Christ, where we worshipped and worked when we lived in Knoxville while I was at East Tennessee School of Preaching (ETSPM). Another congregation that will be helping with the campaign is the Karn's church of Christ which oversees ESTPM; so we are very excited about this opportunity to return to Honduras with the people that we worked and worshiped with during our time in Knoxville.

We are writing you and asking if you would be willing to help us in our endeavor to return to Honduras to help the people of San Francisco receive medical attention and also the spiritual healing that can only come from the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The trip campaign will take place in late July and we would like to ask for your assistance with the funding of our trip. With the costs of transportation, team costs, accommodations and other incidentals that we will incur we are asking and praying for your help funding our trip. It doesn't matter about the amount; anything that you can and are willing to give is greatly appreciated and will be used to help spread the Gospel in Honduras. If you are unable to help us financially at this time we petition you for your prayers for this campaign to Honduras.
