LET'S GROW WITH JESUS!

“And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man” Luke 2:52.

1. **Jesus increased in wisdom—MENTALLY.** James said, “If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally” (1:5). We must strive for the “wisdom that is from above” and shun “earthly, sensual, devilish” wisdom (James 3:15, 17).
2. **Jesus increased in stature — PHYSICALLY.** Jesus was a worker. Some may think Jesus was weak and frail. Yet, He endured the torture of scouring, bearing His cross and the crucifixion. Jesus was not weak, He was meek (Matt. 1:29).
3. **Jesus increased in favor with God — SPIRITUALLY.** Jesus’ life and teachings were in perfect harmony (Heb. 4:15); He practiced what He preached. God said, “Thou are my beloved son, in whom I am well pleased” (Luke 3:22). We must strive for “godliness” and “growth” (I Tim. 4:8; I Peter 3:18). We must “set our affection on things above” (Col. 3:2).
4. **Jesus increased in favor with man — SOCIALLY.** Jesus cared about people. He provided for their needs and cared for their soul (Luke 19:10). He accepted them as they were, seeing their great potential and helped them to be better. He loved the sinner and hated the sin. Peter said, “He went about doing good” (Acts 10:38). Our focus must be on the soul (Matt. 16:26).

Conclusion: If you are looking for a hero, look no further. Jesus is your perfect model. Follow in His steps and he will lead you to heaven.

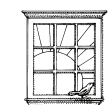
